*Maipo, Chile*  
*There is a mouth-watering combination of ripe, lemony citrus fruit and balancing acidity in this typically well made white from the middle of Chile. Excellent as an apéritif or with white meats.*
8. **Amori Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie** £4.75 £8.95 £25.95  
*Veneto, Italy*  
*Delicately floral and light in body, with crisp fruit and a very subtle touch of honey on the finish.*

*Wonderfully aromatic on the nose with some tropical passionfruit character amongst the grassy, herby notes of New Zealand.*

***Beauséjour***

*Loire Valley, France*

*Lovely weight of gooseberry fruit with a beautiful mineral element on the finish.*

24. ***Picpoul de Pinet*** £31.95

*Domaine des Lauriers, France*

*Piquepoul is a very localised white grape growing just inland of the Mediterranean shore south of Montpellier. Fresh, lean, steely, mineral and bone dry.*

**Fruity & Aromatic Whites**

25. ***Moselland Riesling Spätlese*** £28.95

*Mosel, Germany*

*The Riesling is the classic grape of Germany and this wine from late-harvested grapes is very typical of its racy, elegant style, with the sweetness balanced by juicy freshness.*

26. ***Los Coches Viognier*** £25.95

*Maipo Valley, Chile*

*Classic Viognier character of apricots, peaches hints of pears and blossom. Full on the palate but with lively citrusy character which keeps it from being too much.*

27. ***Il Palu, Pinot Grigio, Friuli Grave*** £27.95

*Veneto, Italy*

*This is proper Pinot Grigio, full bodied with a palate of very ripe fruit, a smoky note and a lick of fine acidity.*

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***Bold & Flavourful Whites***

28. ***Pask 'Gimblett Gravels' Chardonnay, Hawke's Bay*** £31.95  
*North Island, New Zealand*  
*Unoaked, elegant and fresh, with pure pineapple and peach fruit.*
29. ***Baboon Rock Unwooded Chardonnay, Franschhoek, La Petite Ferme*** £35.95  
*Franschhoek, South Africa*  
*Honey and lime aromas lead to pear flavours with mineral undertones.*
30. ***Chablis, Jean de Chaudenay*** £51.95  
*Burgundy, France*  
*Crisp, firm Chablis with good fruit and plenty of minerality, juicy and elegant. A fine example of this classic wine.*
31. ***Dopff and Irion Gewurztraminer, Cuvée René Dopff*** £38.95  
*Alsace and Jura, France*  
*A spicy, rose petal nose then a firm, fruit-filled palate, with typical lychee and Turkish Delight flavours.*
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***Light & Fruity Reds***

- 32. *L&F Loron Pinot Noir, Vin de France*** **£31.95**  
*Pays d'Oc & Vin de France*  
*Proper, classic, slightly savoury and perfectly fresh Pinot, with crunchy red fruit flavours and a fine leafy character.*
- 33. *Fleurie, Domaine des Communaux, Jacques Charlet*** **£49.95**  
*Beaujolais, France*  
*Seduces with its elegance and smoothness. A combination of floral red berry fruits.*
- 34. *Tanners Red Burgundy, Bourgogne Pinot Noir*** **£56.95**  
*Maison Roche de Bellene, Burgundy, France*  
*Made by the talented Nicolas Potel this is a delicious, ripe, elegant Pinot Noir with strawberry fruit, good length and grip, from de-classified 'village' wines.*
- 35. *Chianti Colli Senesi, Borgo Alla Terra*** **£34.95**  
*Geografico, Tuscany, Italy*  
*Brick red in colour with a nose of cherries and spice, medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.*
- 36. *Castillo Monjardin Pinot Noir, El Cerezo, Navarra*** **£33.95**  
*Catalonia, Spain*  
*A rich, ripe style of Pinot with black fruits, silky tannins, great balance and lovely purity to the fruit .*
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***Medium Bodied Reds***

- 37. *Côtes-du-Rhône, Vieilles Vignes,*** **£28.95**  
***Cave Coteaux du Rhone***  
*Rhône Valley, France*  
*Proper, classic, slightly savoury and perfectly fresh Pinot, with crunchy red fruit flavours and a fine leafy character.*
- 38. *Pomerol*** **£69.95**  
*St-Emilion and Right Bank, France*  
*This has lovely plummy fruit, is soft and concentrated, but also long and elegant.*
- 39. *Rioja Vega Crianza*** **£36.95**  
*Spain*  
*Aged in oak for 18 months and showing soft fruit and oak aromas with fine tannins.*
- 40. *Aldonia Vendimia, Rioja*** **£31.95**  
*Spain*  
*Bright Strawberry and cranberry fruit with liquorice, citrus, chocolate and vanilla.*
- 41. *Terra de Lobos Castelao/Cabernet Sauvignon*** **£28.95**  
*Mid and South Portugal*  
*There are some terrific wines coming out of the south of Portugal, this wine shows the potential of this region. Full of the lovely crunchy fruit with floral hints on the nose, the palate is weighty with rich red and black fruit character.*
- 42. *Freedom Cross, Pinotage*** **£26.95**  
*Western Cape, South Africa*  
*Pinotage is South Africa's unique grape. This example is softly styled with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.*
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***Rich, Full Bodied Reds***

- 43. *Côtes du Rhône-Villages*** £36.95  
*Château Courac, Rhône Valley, France*  
*Lots of succulent, ripe, supple sweet fruit with hints of cassis, damson, cherry and herby undertones. Lovely round tannins with a refreshing vein of acidity and excellent length.*
- 44. *Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Les Galets de la Berthaud, Roger Perrin*** £69.95  
*Rhône Valley, France*  
*A superb Chateauneuf that delivers gentle bramble fruit, dried herbs and a soft, rounded palate.*
- 45. *Château Montaignillon, Montagne Saint-Emilion*** £48.95  
*Bordeaux, France*  
*Plums, blackcurrants and cherries backed up by good structure and ripe tannins.*
- 46. *Cantele Negroamaro, Salento*** £34.95  
*Puglia, Southern Italy*  
*A spicy round and delicious wine from the Negroamaro grape, which many consider to be the best grape of Puglia. Black cherry jam and mocha chocolate aromas are followed by stewed, herby black fruit.*
- 47. *River Grandeur Shiraz, Robertson, Viljoensdrift*** £35.95  
*Breede River Valley, South Africa*  
*Juicy and tasty with red and dark berry fruit and peppery flavours on the finish.*
- 48. *Gougenheim Cabernet Sauvignon, Tupungato*** £32.95  
*Valle Escondido, Mendoza, Argentina*  
*Intense and juicy, aromatic blackcurrant fruit, with velvety soft tannins and attractive toasty oak. Dense, yet fresh and easy-going with a big focus on fruit.*

*Valle Escondido, Mendoza, Argentina*  
*A rich dark wine, with red and black fruit character on the nose and palate, a delicious creamy vanilla spice character and a lovely lifted finish.*
